On Sunday, the Main Parade starts at 12noon. Vendors may stay beyond 1pm as desired.

FEES: Booth space is about 10x12 ft. Cost is \$25.00 each day.

Electricity IS available on a limited basis. Please indicate if you will need electricity. Cost is \$20.00 flat rate, whether for 1 or 3 days.

PERMITS: FOOD vendors MUST have a PERMIT. Please enclose a copy of your permit with your application and fees.

NO Inside Space: There is no inside space available at this time. Please bring shelter to protect your products!
